Family membership

This is a scheme where not more than two Adult members living at the same address or two Adult members with any number of Junior members living at the same or different addresses may, at the discretion of the General Committee, qualify for a reduced subscription.

Duties

New members are not expected to fulfil duties in their first year but volunteers will be much appreciated. In subsequent years all Adult members are expected to fulfil 3 Race Control (OoD, AOoD) duties or Sunday afternoon tea duties. This is reduced to 4 in total for a family membership.

Insurance

All boats must be protected by current third party indemnity of no less than £2,000,000. Please sign for each boat to confirm you have current insurance which you will maintain to cover the boat at all times when it is at SSC.

Canoes

If the owner of a canoe is a member of the BCU and does not wish to keep their canoe at the club no fee is payable. If they are not a member of the BCU **or** they wish to leave their canoe at the club the Small Craft fee is payable.

Outboard Motors

Please note that SSC is a sailing club that allows canoeing and rowing.

Outboards may be used as a “get me home” facility in emergency and not as the prime mover

Please sign and return all renewal forms to the Honorary Membership Secretary regardless of whether you pay by cheque or Faster Payment (BACS).

Membership Renewal

In subsequent years fees are due between January 1st and February 28th at a discounted rate. This is similar to the new membership rate. Fees received after February 28th will be at a higher rate.
