

# **Severn Sailing Club Notice of Race AASC Wardle Trophy Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> and Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2019**

## **1. RYA Racing Charter**

1.1 Competitors should note that Severn Sailing Club has adopted the RYA racing Charter and that they will be required to undertake to sail in compliance with the Charter, which can be found at the front of the RYA rule book (Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020), on the official Severn sailing Club notice board or at [www.rya.org.uk/racing/charter](http://www.rya.org.uk/racing/charter).

## **2. Rules**

2.1 Races will be governed by the 'Rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020 except as they are changed by the sailing instructions, class rules, the prescriptions of the RYA and this Notice of Race.

## **3. Conditions of Entry**

3.1 The safety of the boat and its entire management, including insurance shall be the sole responsibility of the competitor(s) racing the boat.

3.2 All craft on the club premises (on land and on the water) must have full insurance cover, including third party liability to £2,000,000. All craft intended to be used for racing must have appropriate insurance cover.

3.3 The race organisers shall not be liable for any loss, damage, death or personal injury howsoever caused to the owner/competitor, his skipper or crew, as a result of their taking part in the race or races. Moreover, every owner/competitor warrants the suitability of his yacht for the race or races.

## **4. Organising Authority**

4.1 The organising authority is Severn Sailing Club.

## **5. Entry and Registration**

5.1 The entry fees for the event are £10.00 per boat.

5.2 Boats shall be entered by completing registration with the organising authority and shall produce a completed entry form and entry fee.

5.3 Registration will be open from 11:30 on Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> June and 10:00 on Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> June.

## **6. Event and Programme**

6.1 There will be a briefing for all competitors at 13:30 on Saturday 1st June and 11:30 on Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> June.

6.2 There are 5 races scheduled of which 3 constitute a series. The following will also apply:

- If 5 races are sailed, 3 will count towards the result.
- If 4 races are sailed, 3 will count towards the result.
- If only 3 races are sailed then all 3 races will count towards the result

6.3 The Schedule of racing is as follows:

- Race 1, Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> June, 14:00
- Race 2 will be as soon after race 1 as practically possible.
- Race 3, Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> June 12:00
- Lunch
- Race 4 no earlier than 14:00
- Race 5 will be as soon after race 4 as practically possible.
- Prize-giving will be as soon as practicable after the last race.

These are subject to alteration at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

## **7. The Course**

7.1 The courses will be displayed on the race officers hut and sailed on the River Avon.

## **8. Scoring**

8.1 The low point scoring system will apply as set out in RRS 2017-2020

## **9. Prizes**

9.1 Prizes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup>. Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organising authority.

## **10. Overnight Accommodation.**

10.1 Competitors are more than welcome to camp overnight on the Saturday evening, please advise the contact below if you wish to do so.
